

UPDATED AUGUST 23, 2022



We are now navigating our 3rd dance season through the obstacles of a pandemic and the safety of our dancers, staff and dance families continues to be at the forefront of the guidelines we set forth at All for Dance. We pride ourselves on abiding by standards and implementing strategies to create a safe environment for all families, even the most concerned.

It is helpful to know that dance is considered a low risk sport. A low risk sport is defined as a sport that can be done individually.

Hand sanitizing stations are located at the entrance and exit of every studio as well as in all lobbies. Dancers will sanitize their hands at the beginning and end of each class.

Many steps have been taken to improve air quality. UV lighting has been installed in our HVAC system to help eliminate contaminants. Air purifiers are located in all lobbies and classrooms. Studio doors are left open during class to increase air circulation, when possible.

All frequently touched surfaces are cleaned on a regular basis.

Dancers enter through one set of studio doors and exit another to reduce traffic and crowding.

We are aligning our studio COVID protocols to the recent CDC guidance released on August 11, 2022 as follows:

- COVID POSITIVE - If your dancer tests positive for COVID-19, they must stay home for at least 5 days. If after 5 days they are fever-free for 24 hours without the use of medication, and their symptoms are improving, or they never had symptoms, they may return to dance wearing a high-quality mask through day 10.
- COVID POSITIVE CLOSE CONTACT EXPLOSURE IN SAME HOUSEHOLD - If your dancer has had close contact with a member of their household, the CDC recommends wearing a mask in public for 10 days from the date of their close contact exposure.

Virtual Classes



Offering virtual class options is a great way to keep our dancers that are impacted by COVID dancing at home, if they feel well enough to participate. Be sure to review the following virtual class protocols that we will follow this season:

- Virtual classes will be offered via ZOOM to dancers that are testing positive for COVID or under quarantine.
- A request for a virtual class link must be emailed to questions@alldfordancestudio.com.
- We require at least 24 hours notice to create the virtual class link, prepare our faculty and reply to your email request with a ZOOM link.

We are happy to share that we have a plan to slowly navigate reopening our lobbies this season. We will begin our season as follows:

- One parent/guardian is allowed to stay in the lobby for our Tiny Tot (3 year old) and Pre Kinder (4 year old), Kinder (5 year old) and Hip Hop KiDZ classes only.
- Chairs will be marked with signs that say Reserved (Tiny Tot, Pre Kinder, Kinder & Hip Hop KiDZ parent only). A "Parent Visitor" badge will be given to the parent/guardian of our Tiny Tot, Pre Kinder, Kinder and Hip Hop KiDZ visitors so that our staff can easily identify those parents/guardians that are allowed to stay.

For all other classes, once class begins, we kindly ask you to wait outside once your dancer is successfully in the classroom. Our faculty will escort dancers to the exit door to meet you on the sidewalk at the end of class. We will revisit our lobby guidelines regularly throughout the season.
