Monthly rates are based upon a 9 month payment plan for the total tuition due per class.

The monthly tuition for a 30 minute class is \$49.50 (\$445.50 for the season).

The monthly tuition for a 45 minute class is \$55.00 (\$495.00 for the season).

The monthly tuition for a 60 minute class is \$61.50 (\$553.50 for the season).

The monthly tuition for a 75 minute class is \$70.50 (\$634.50 for the season).

The tuition for an 8 week session of Dance with Me, Hip Hop KiDZ, Cheer Dance, Flex/Turns/Leaps and PBT is \$125.00.

Multiple class discounts are offered to students participating in more than one class. A 10% discount is offered on the 2nd class and a 15% discount is offered on the 3rd, 4th, 5th and 6th class. Tuition calculations will be ordered from the class with the longest length to shortest length for discount purposes. Additional family discounts are available, 5 % for the 2nd child and 10 % for the 3rd child, 4th child, etc.

All registered students must be enrolled in our Automatic Payment program. Tuition will be automatically charged on the 5th of the month to a credit card, debit card or checking account. Declined payments must be resolved by the 10th of the month.

If an account is 30 days delinquent, a written notice will be issued and the student will only be allowed to observe class. After 45 days, the student will not be allowed in class.

Registration fees and tuition are non-refundable and non-transferable. Credits are not provided for absences or drop-outs. Make up classes are offered upon request.

## Cancellation



If you decide to cancel class at any point during the dance year, you must provide written confirmation of the cancellation via email to [questions@allfordancestudio.com](mailto:questions@allfordancestudio.com). Tuition will be due through the end of the month in which the cancellation occurs. Tuition will not be charged for any future months.

ALL CLASSES – Hair must be pulled back out of the face, preferably in a ponytail. Please put your child's name inside all shoes.

## Dress Code



DANCE WITH ME - Pink tights & a black or pink leotard are recommended for class. Dancers will also need Ballet shoes & Tap shoes. You may follow the recommend brands mentioned below for Tiny Tot dance if you would like although color and brand for this age group is flexible. Parents participating are recommended to wear activewear.

TINY TOT DANCE, PRE KINDER DANCE, KINDER DANCE & ADVANCED COMBINATION - Pink tights & a black or pink leotard are required for class. On days where we start with Tap first, dancers may wear other colored leotards. Ballet skirts are optional but recommended. Dancers will need Bloch Belle and Tan Tap shoes by Bloch. Please be sure the shoes fit your child's foot appropriately. We prefer that the ties not be worn in the tap shoes as they become untied often during class. A dance bag is also needed to carry all dance shoes into the classroom.

JUNIOR PETITE BALLE, PETITE BALLE & SENIOR PETITE BALLE - Pink tights & a black leotard are required for class. Ballet skirts are optional but recommended. Dancers will need Bloch Belle.

JUNIOR BALLE, SENIOR BALLE, ELITE BALLE & BALLE FUNDAMENTALS - Pink tights & a black leotard are required for class. Ballet skirts are optional but recommended. Dancers will need Canvas Ballet Shoes by Sansha or Capezio canvas Ballet Shoes called Sculpture II.

JUNIOR PETITE TAP, PETITE TAP & SENIOR PETITE TAP & TAP FUNDAMENTALS – Tights & a leotard are required for class. Dance pants or shorts may be worn over their tights. Dancers will need Tan Tie Tap shoes. Please be sure the shoes fit your child's foot appropriately. We prefer that the ties not be worn in the tap shoes as they become untied often during class.

JUNIOR TAP, SENIOR TAP & ELITE TAP – Tights & a leotard are required for class. Dance pants or shorts may be worn over their tights. Dancers will need Black Oxford Tie or Slip-on Tap Shoes. Tap shoes must have rubber on the bottom.

JUNIOR PETITE JAZZ, PETITE JAZZ, SENIOR PETITE JAZZ, JUNIOR JAZZ, SENIOR JAZZ & JAZZ FUNDAMENTALS – Tights & a leotard are required for class. Dance pants or shorts may be worn over their tights. Dancers will need Suntan Jazz Neoflex Slip-on Shoes – Style #495 - by Bloch or the Bloch Pulse Jazz Shoe.

ELITE JAZZ - Tights & a leotard are required for class. Dance pants or shorts may be worn over their tights. Dancers will need Suntan Jazz Neoflex Slip-on Shoes – Style #495 - by Bloch or the Bloch Pulse Jazz Shoe. Dancers will also need a pair of tan character shoes. We recommend a 1 1/2" to 2" heel. A shoe with a t-strap is allowed but not required.

## Dress Code



PETITE, SENIOR PETITE, JUNIOR AND SENIOR HIP HOP – Dancers should wear yoga pants, sweatpants or leggings with knees covered. Shorts are allowed but dancers must wear tights. Dancers should wear a fitted top or loose t-shirt with tank top or leotard underneath. Jeans are not allowed in class. No outside street shoes are allowed in class. Black Nike Sneakers with white bottom and white Nike symbol are needed for class.

MODERN - Tights & a leotard are required for class. Tights should be footless as students will be dancing with bare feet.

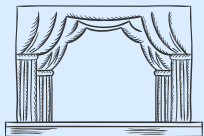
MUSICAL THEATRE - Tights & a leotard are required for class. Dance pants or shorts may be worn over their tights. Dancers will need Suntan Jazz Neoflex Slip-On Shoes – Style #495 by Bloch or Bloch Pulse Jazz shoe.

LYRICAL JAZZ - Tights & a leotard are required for class. Tights should be footless. Dancers will need Capezio Pirouette II shoes for class.

CONTEMPORARY - Tights & a leotard are required for class. Tights should be footless as students will be dancing with bare feet.

BOYS – For Ballet class, we prefer black pants, a white t-shirt and black Ballet shoes. For all other classes, please wear athletic wear. Shoes for Jazz are black jazz shoes. For Tap, please wear black tie Tap shoes. For Hip Hop, please wear Black Nike sneakers with white swoosh and white bottoms.

## Recital Info



Our 2023 recital is scheduled for May 20 & May 21 at the Bordentown Performing Arts Center.

All classes, unless otherwise specified, will participate in a dance recital in May. Student participation is optional. All students not participating in the dance recital must let us know by November 1. All students participating in the recital are required to purchase costumes. Please see the section titled COSTUME INFORMATION for additional details.

Tickets to our recital will be sold online in April 2023. The estimated ticket price is \$25. In addition to recital tickets, each dancer participating will be charged a recital fee. The estimated recital fee is \$30 per dancer. This fee will include a digital download of the recital.

## Costume Info



Recital costumes will be ordered in November. The average costume price ranges from \$80 to \$100 with all accessories.

Full payment must be made at the time of order. Costumes will not be ordered if payment has not been received in full.

## Class Rules



Please be sure your child arrives at the beginning of class. Missing crucial warm-ups at the beginning of class could result in injury.

Excessive absences could result in a change of class level. Please notify the studio if a student is going to be absent.

Please have students dressed in the proper dance clothes with hair pulled up in a ponytail or bun. Please check the dress code section of our policies for details by class.

No gum or food is permitted at the studio at this time unless it is medically necessary.

No parents or observers will be permitted in the classroom while class is in session, unless previously arranged.

Any student who is disruptive during class will be asked to leave.

## COVID 19



All for Dance strictly follows the CDC and NJ Department of Health guidelines for youth activities.

Our HVAC system has UV lighting to help fight germs and improve air quality.
